





2021 REGIONAL NEEDS ASSESSMENT KEY FINDINGS



In 2021, Kaufman County's population makeup was approximately 63% White Alone, 23% Hispanic, 11% Black Alone, 1% Asian and 2% identifying as a race other than listed. (Texas Demographic Center)

Kaufman County saw an estimated 8% population increase from 2017 to 2021; the 4th highest of all Region 3 counties. (Texas Demographic Center)


In 2019, Kaufman County had a median household income of \$70,107; this is higher than Texas and United States [\$61,874 and \$62,843]. (U.S. Census Bureau)

In 2020, Kaufman County had the second highest rate of recipients for the public assistance program TANF in Region 3. (Texas Health and Human Services Commission)
- 

62% of students in Kaufman County were eligible to receive either free or reduced-price lunch during the 2019-2020 school year. (U.S. Department of Education)

During the 2020-2021 school year, the rate of students experiencing homelessness in Kaufman County was 5 per 1,000 students. (Texas Education Agency)
- 

In 2020, Kaufman County had the second highest rate of arrests for drug equipment violations in Region 3. (Texas Department of Public Safety)
- 

In 2020, Kaufman County had the highest rate of infant mortality of all Region 3 counties. (Texas Department of State Health Services)
- 

During the 2019-2020 school year, Kaufman County had the third highest rates of out-of-school suspensions for substance use infractions in Region 3. (Texas Education Agency)
- 

As of July 2021, Kaufman County had 3 licensed substance abuse and 4 mental health treatment providers. (SAMHSA)
